

Earlier, reports suggested that urban local body and panchayat elections in Jammu and Kashmir are likely to be delayed as the administration is mulling changes to municipal acts and rules to address skewed distribution of electors.

The administration is considering the delimitation carried out by the Election Commission for assembly and parliamentary seats, said an official, requesting anonymity. The Housing and Urban Development Department is actively pursuing a communication from the office of the Chief Electoral Officer, which, among other things, suggested transfer of mandate to conduct the municipal electoral processes to the State Election Commission (SEC) in accordance with constitutional provisions. The five-year term of most of the municipalities, including the Jammu Municipal Corporation (JMC) and the Srinagar Municipal Corporation (SMC), ends this month, while the term of panchayats is expiring on January 9 next year. The term of the SMC ended on November 5 and the JMC's ended on November 14. The tenure of block development councils (BDCs) and district development councils (DDCs) is ending in October 2024 and January 2026, respectively.

The last ULB and Panchayat elections were held between October and December 2018 after a long delay.

The CEO's office, in its letter, also referred to various petitioners who have objected to the large-scale difference in the electoral base of each seat of the two municipal corporations and demanded a fresh delimitation of all bodies.

"...there is a large difference in the elector bases of different wards wherein there are wards with elector Plant at Wagoora under Unnati Multistate Cooperatives, bases in the range of 2,000 to 3,000 on one side and 12,000 to 15,000 on the other extreme. Similar variance is there in most of the municipal councils and committees also. This skew in the representation strength of each ward can be addressed by a fresh delimitation exercise," the letter said.

The officials said the rural development department is also considering the demand for rationalization of electorates in panchayat segments.

It said the demand for reservation of other backward classes in consonance with constitutional provisions was also highlighted.

Out of the 75 wards of the JMC, having 4,65,794 voters, 25 wards are reserved for women, 10 for scheduled castes and two for scheduled tribes. Similarly, and members of Cooperative Societies were presentin the 75 wards of the SMC, having 7,46,711 voters, 25 wards were reserved for women.

Quoting a Supreme Court ruling on the subject forwarded by the petitioners in support of their demand, the CEO's office said that "if reservation has to be made in favour of OBCs then corresponding amendments in municipal acts and rules are required".

They said the elections to ULBs and Panchayats is likely to be held next year after completion of the ongoing process. KNO

India-China in dialogue mode

mid the ongoing standoff between India and China in the strategicallyimportant Eastern Ladakh, there are reports that the two sides have been regularly holding talks at local levels during past few days to ensure that problems don't emerge during readjustments along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in the region ahead of harsh winter season of over three months. This is despite the fact that there had been no breakthrough achieved through talks that had been held for 20 rounds so far. If the officials are to be believed, the dialogue is the part of Confidence Building Measures (CBMs) which have been agreed upon during last month's Corps Commander level talks at Chushul Moldo in Eastern Ladakh on October 9 and 10. Two sides are yet to achieve any breakthrough in the dialogue process but they have exuded confidence that continuous and progressive talks may bring some change on ground. The talks which are going on for nearly a week may continue for a few more days depending upon the requirements. These developments are a good sign as it is expected to help two sides to normalize relations and maintain peace to the best possible extent especially at a time when harsh winter is about to set-in along the LAC and will continue till March. This is happening against the backdrop of the recent provocation of China when it denied entry of some Indian sportspersons belonging to Arunachal Pradesh into the 19th Asian Games being hosted by it. The Chinese government's action received expected reaction from Indians where the Minister of Information and Broadcasting and Sports Anurag Thakur cancelled his scheduled visit to China for the Games. India has also lodged a strong protest in New Delhi and Beijing against this. The Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India believed that 'China's action violates both the spirit of the Asian Games and the rules governing their conduct, which explicitly prohibits discrimination against competitors from member states'. Earlier to that, Chinese troops had provoked India by erecting four tents in Table Top area of Gurung Hills in Chushul area along the LAC in Eastern Ladakh-an area which had been declared as buffer zone by the two armies-PLA and Indian Army. It was a complete violation of the disengagement agreement. The Chinese action of installation of tents in the buffer zone was noticed by the locals who sounded troops. Buffer zones have been created in five regions of Ladakh as part of disengagement talks in the aftermath of the clash at Galwan in June 2020 and the subsequent buildup of Chinese and Indian armies along the Line of Actual Control. Amid this standoff, two countries have enhanced their developmental activities along the undemarcated LAC which is also one of the reasons for escalating tensions between India and China. China has reportedly intensified its activities for development of infrastructure in the region. On the other hand, India too has expedited its construction activities to build a better infrastructure for armed forces at the time of emergency. It is high time for two sides to settle all issues amicably by holding regular talks, like they have been doing for the past few days, to ensure long-lasting peace on borders.

'OCD is a result of imbalanced learning between reinforcement and punishment'

Scientists from the Nara Institute of Science and Technology (NAIST), Advanced Telecommunications Research Institute International, and Tamagawa University have demonstrated that obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD) can be understood as a result of imbalanced learning between reinforcement and punishment. On the basis of empirical tests of their theoretical model, they showed that asymmetries in brain calculations that link current results to past actions can lead to disordered behaviour.

Specifically, this can happen when the memory trace signal for past actions decays differently for good and bad outcomes. In this case, "good" means the result was better than expected, and "bad" means that it was worse than expected. This work helps to explain how OCD develops.

OCD is a mental illness involving anxiety, characterized by intrusive and repetitious thoughts, called obsessions, coupled with certain repeated actions, known as compulsions. Patients with OCD often feel unable to change behaviour even when they know that obsessions or compulsions are not reasonable. In severe cases, these may render the person incapable of leading a normal life. Compulsive behaviours, such as washing hands excessively or repeatedly checking whether doors are locked before leaving the house, are attempts to temporarily relieve anxiety caused by obsessions. However, hitherto, the means by which the cycle of obsessions and compulsions becomes strengthened was not well understood.

Now, a team led by researchers at NAIST has used reinforcement learning theory to model the disordered cycle associated with OCD. In this framework, an outcome that is better than predicted becomes more likely (positive prediction error), while a result that is worse than expected is suppressed (negative prediction error). In the implementation of reinforcement learning, it is also important to consider delays, as well as positive/negative prediction errors. In general, the outcome of a certain choice is available after a certain delay. Therefore, reinforcement and punishment should be assigned to recent choices within a certain time frame. This is called credit assignment, which is implemented as a memory trace in reinforcement learning theory.

Ideally, memory trace signals for past actions decay at equal speed for both positive and negative prediction errors. However, this cannot be completely realized in discrete neural systems. Using simulations. NAIST scientists found that agents implicitly learn obsessive-compulsive behavior when the trace decay factor for memory traces of past actions related to negative prediction errors (n-) is much smaller than that related to positive prediction errors (n+). This means that, from the opposite perspective, the view of past actions is much narrower for negative prediction errors than for positive prediction errors. "Our model, with imbalanced trace decay factors (n + > n) successfully represents the vicious circle of obsession and compulsion characteristic of OCD," said cofirst authors Yuki Sakai and Yutaka Sakai.

To test this prediction, the researchers had 45 patients with OCD and 168 healthy control subjects playing a computer-based game with monetary rewards and penalties. Patients with OCD showed much smaller n- compared with n+, as predicted by computational characteristics of OCD. In addition, this imbalanced setting of trace decay factors (n + > n) was normalized by serotonin enhancers, which are first-line medications for the treatment of OCD. "Although we think that we always make rational decisions, our computational model proves that we sometimes implicitly reinforce maladaptive behaviours," says the corresponding author, Saori C. Tanaka.

A. For Anganwadi Workers

- 1. The candidate must be domicile of the UT of J&K.
- Women candidates in the age group of 18-37 years shall be eligible.
- 3. The candidate should be a resident of the electoral ward where Anganwadi Centre is situated. Name in the voter list for the ward shall be considered as the proof of residence of the candidate. In case the name of the candidate appears in the voter list along with her parents, then she must provide certificate of being un-married issued by the concerned Tehsildar. Where ever, there is any dispute as to residence for any reason, then a residence proof certifying the ward of residence from the concerned SDM/ACR shall be considered.
- 4) Minimum qualification for Anganwadi Worker shall be 10+ 2 and maximum graduation. In case no 10+2 pass candidate is available in the ward, 10+2 pass candidate from the adjoining ward shall be considered which would require prior approval of Mission Director, Mission POSHAN, J&K.
- 5) In case suitable candidate is not available for adjoining ward, candidate from the nearest ward within the ward can be considered subject to the approval of the MD, Mission POSHAN.
- 6) Weightage shall be given on the basis of marks obtained in 10+2 and selection shall be done purely on merit basis and not other criteria to be considered.
- 7) In case of tie in merit of the eligible candidate, candidate with higher age will be preferred.
- 8) Candidate with qualification higher than graduation shall not be considered.

B. Anganwadi Helpers(Sahayikas)

- 1. The selection of Helper shall be restricted to the electoral ward where Anganwadi Centre is located.
- 2. Women candidates in the age group of 18-37 years shall be eligible.
- 3. The candidate must be domicile of the UT of J&K.
- 4. Minimum qualification for Anganwadi Helper shall be matriculation.
- 5. In case no matriculate candidate available in the ward, candidates with qualification not less than 8th standard shall be considered.
- 6. The committee shall select the most destitute/needy married woman of the ward as helper from amongst those who fulfil the qualification criteria. In case no married candidate is available, unmarried candidate may be considered.
- 7.
