Rusted grenade found in Kishtwar **JI NEWS SERVICE**

KISHTWAR/JAMMU, FEB 25

A rusted grenade was found on the roadside in Jammu and Kashmir's Kishtwar district on Sunday, police said. Kishtwar Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Abdul Qayoom said the explosive device was noticed at Zargar Mohalla by a local resident, who immediately informed the police.

Qayoom said a bomb disposal squad was summoned and the HE-36 hand grenade was safely removed from the scene.

"The grenade is in a rusty condition, indicating that it was lying there for a very long time. There was some construction work undertaken about four to five months ago and the debris was dumped here. Prima facie, it appears that the device was present in the debris and was exposed due to recent rains," the SSP said.


Resolve to give Modi govt third term with more than 400 LS seats: Shah to BJP workers



A diesel locomotive-hauled freight train travelled more than 70 kilometres from Jammu and Kashmir's Kathua to a village in Punjab's Hoshiarpur district without its drivers on Sunday, officials said.

Dr Pandita presented his work of the English translation of the book on the history of medieval Kashmir 'Baharistan -i-Shahi' to the Lt Governor.







Alpine skier Bobby Pandey's parallel slalom gold at the Kangdoori slopes made the difference on the final day of the Khelo India Winter Games 2024 in Gulmarg on Sunday. Pandey's victory helped Army finish on top of the medal tally with 10 golds, just one more than Karnataka and three more than No. 3 Maharashtra, the table toppers at the end of the first round of the winter Games in Ladakh from February 2-5.

In Sunday's only other event, Mehak of Uttarkhand won the women's version of the parallel slalom. Uttarkhand finished fifth in the medal standings with three golds. All these came in different skiing events. Spearheaded by Aanchal Thakur's double gold, Himachal Pradesh finished No. 4 with four gold medals.

Army, which had won the ice-hockey gold in Ladakh, returned with nine golds in the Gulmarg edition of KIWG 2024. Snowboarder Kulvinder Sharma and Nordic skier Padma Namgial produced outstanding performances with two individual gold medals each for the Army team. Karnataka, which did well in Ladakh primarily due to their ice-skaters, competed well in Gulmarg largely due to top skier Thekkada Bhavani Nanjunda. The 28-year-old certified trainer and a mountaineer, Bhavani was the only athlete to win a hattrick of gold medals in Gulmarg. Whether the train had been "secured" properly at Kathua on the down gradient is a matter of investigation, the spokesperson said and added that an in-depth probe is underway.



Rising speculations of simultaneous LS, **Assembly polls**

he upcoming visit of the full Election Commission of India (ECI) to Jammu and Kashmir on March 12 and 13 has fuelled the speculations of simultaneous Lok Sabha and much-awaited Assembly polls in Jammu and Kashmir. The ECI will chair two high-level security review meetings besides interacting with political parties and other stakeholders in Jammu and Kashmir to ensure fool-proof security for parliament elections scheduled to be held in April-May and assess when the Assembly polls can be held in the Union Territory. Former chief minister and veteran National Conference leader Farooq Abdullah too has predicted that assembly elections in J&K will be held with general elections while his son Omar Abdullah while targeting the ECI has said that it was "a matter of considerable shame" that the Supreme Court had to issue a directive about elections in Jammu and Kashmir rather than the poll body. The Apex Court has directed that the assembly elections should be held in Jammu and Kashmir by the end of September 2024. A BJP faction also favours assembly polls with Lok Sabha elections. The last Assembly elections were held in 2014 and it has been almost a decade since J&K has witnessed no electoral exercise for the Legislative Assembly. The delaying assembly elections in Jammu and Kashmir are a complex decision with significant implications for the region's political landscape and the aspirations of its people. Several factors contribute to the debate surrounding this issue, including security concerns, political instability, and the restoration of democratic processes. One of the primary arguments for delaying elections is the security situation in J&K. The region has faced decades of unrest, with ongoing tensions between separatist groups, militants, and security forces. Holding elections in such a volatile environment poses risks to both candidates and voters. Ensuring the safety and security of all involved is paramount, and postponing elections may be seen as a measure to mitigate potential violence and instability. Furthermore, there are concerns about the readiness of the political landscape in I&K for free and fair elections. The abrogation of Article 370 in 2019 fundamentally altered the region's political dynamics, leading to the dissolution of the state's special status and the bifurcation of the erstwhile state into two union territories. The subsequent detention of political leaders and restrictions on civil liberties further complicated the situation. Delaying elections could provide time for political parties to regroup, reorganize, and engage in meaningful dialogue to address the grievances of the people of J&K. However, the decision to delay elections is not without its critics. Some argue that prolonged suspension of democratic processes undermines the principles of representative governance and deprives the people of J&K of their right to choose their leaders. They argue that democracy requires continuous engagement and participation, and any delay in elections perpetuates a sense of disenfranchisement among the populace. Additionally, the absence of elected representatives in J&K hampers the region's development and governance to some extent. Delaying elections further prolongs the state of the political vacuum, hindering the prospects for meaningful progress and reconciliation in the region. Although top officials are tightlipped over the timing of the assembly elections in Jammu and Kashmir, a group within the BJP is advocating that Assembly polls in Jammu and Kashmir must be held with the Lok Sabha elections to reap the political benefits of the prevailing wave in favour of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The ruling dispensation at the Centre should silence the criticism of opposition parties while taking a firm stand on conducting assembly elections in Jammu and Kashmir without any further delay.




