

### Six additional judges appointed to Kerala HC, one to J&K HC

Six advocates and a judicial officer were appointed as judges in two high courts on Thursday.

According to a Law Ministry statement, advocates Mullappally Abdul Aziz Abdul Hakhim, Syam Kumar Vadakke Mudavakkat, Harisankar Vijayan Menon, Manu Sreedharan Nair, Easwaran Subramani and Manoj Pulamby Madhavan have been appointed as additional judges of the Kerala High Court.

Judicial officer Mohd Yousuf Wani has been appointed as an additional judge of the Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh High Court.

Separately, 10 additional judges of the Bombay High Court have been elevated as permanent judges.

Additional judges are usually appointed for a period of two years before being elevated as judges or what is popularly called "permanent judges".

Peoples Democratic Party president Mehbooba Mufti on Thursday said voting is the only power left with people of Jammu and Kashmir as the BIPruled Centre is making all efforts to suppress their voices

"All kinds of injustices are being done and Jammu and Kashmir has been turned into a jail. To suppress the voice of people here, Amit Shah broke the PDP. They took away legislators, ministers and members of parliament from the PDP so that they can finish off the voice of the party," Mufti told reporters in Anantnag district, 55 kilometres from here.



# Ladakh's Quest for Statehood, Sixth Schedule

The Kargil Democratic Alliance (KDA) has taken a bold step by announcing a four-day hunger strike starting from March 24 in solidarity with climate activist-cum-educationist Sonam Wangchuk. Wangchuk's 21-day-long fast, aimed at supporting two crucial demands of the Ladakhi people - statehood for Ladakh and the region's inclusion in the Sixth Schedule of the Constitution – has entered its 15th day in Leh town. The decision to go on a hunger strike was made public during a gathering of protestors at Fatima Chowk, where KDA leaders addressed a large crowd. The protest march, which saw significant participation from local residents, resulted in a half-day shutdown of business and commercial establishments across Kargil. The KDA members emphasized the importance of their demands for Ladakh's statehood and inclusion in the Sixth Schedule. They highlighted the unity among KDA members, all of whom are set to participate in the hunger strike at Gandhi Park from March 24 to 27, pending permission from the district administration. The solidarity expressed by KDA with Sonam Wangchuk's hunger strike underscores the shared commitment towards addressing the longstanding grievances and aspirations of the Ladakhi people. It reflects a collective determination to raise awareness and push for meaningful action on crucial issues affecting the region's future. The KDA emphasized the significance of the hunger strike as a symbol of solidarity and gratitude towards Wangchuk for amplifying Ladakh's voice on the national stage. The appeal for mass participation in the hunger strike highlights the broadbased support for Ladakh's demands, transcending political affiliations and differences. In parallel to these developments, KDA leaders are scheduled to meet with the Leh Apex Body (LAB) in Leh town to strategize their next steps. This meeting assumes particular importance against the backdrop of the upcoming Lok Sabha elections and the ongoing dialogue with the central government regarding Ladakh's demands. The failure of previous talks with the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) to yield concrete outcomes has added urgency to the collective action taken by KDA and other stakeholders. The refusal of the central government to accept Ladakh's key demands has galvanized local leaders and activists, leading to a renewed push for meaningful dialogue and resolution. The BJP's previous commitments regarding Ladakh's status as a tribal area under the Sixth Schedule of the Constitution further underscore the need for concrete action and fulfillment of promises made to the people of Ladakh. As the hunger strike unfolds and discussions continue, it is crucial for all parties involved to prioritize dialogue, inclusivity, and the genuine representation of Ladakh's interests. The hunger strike symbolizes not just a protest but a shared vision for a future where Ladakh's voice is heard, respected, and empowered within the democratic fabric of India. ### **Beta-Glucans Supplement**

fibres known to increase satiety oedema levels and gastrointestinal transit time and delay glucose absorption in the body. For example, studies show that consumption of barley can reduce energy intake and appetite. In addition, some studies have shown significant effects on blood resistance with weight loss as a secondary outcome.

### **Side Effects**

Beta-glucans may cause flatulence. In addition, it does not show any stool consistency, stool frequency, or bloating effects.

**Bitter Orange Supplement** 



Bitter orange contains synephrine. It mimics the action of epinephrine and norepinephrine. In addition, it increases energy expenditure and lipolysis and acts as a mild appetite suppressant. In showed a significant reduction in body fat percentage, fat mass and an increase in BMR. However, there were no conclusive effects on weight loss.

### **Side Effects**

It has been reported that bitter oranges can cause chest pain, headache, anxiety, elevated heart responsible for regulating that the rate, musculoskeletal conditions, ventricular fibrillation, ischemic stroke, myocardial infarction and sometimes death.

### **Caffeine Supplement**

Caffeine is in various herbal sources such as kola nut, yerba mate, and guarana. Methylxanthine stimulates the central ner-

### Green Coffee Bean Extract Supplement

Before roasting, the seeds of the coffee plant have higher levels of Side Effects chlorogenic acid. It inhibits fat accumulation by regulating adipogenesis. In addition, it regulates glucose metabolism and may interfere with glucose absorption in the gut. In animal trials, green bean extract combined with a high-fat diet significantly reduced weight gain and fat mass. The researchers have concluded that green coffee extract moderately affects body weight. Still, the methodological quality of the studies was poor.

### **Side Effects**

Reports show adverse effects

A randomised trial showed like headaches and urinary tract infections. In addition, the caffeine gia lost weight. Still, there was no present in the green coffee beans can act as a stimulant. Therefore, it can cause adverse effects, depending on the dose or if a combination has other stimulants.

It is a mixture of linoleic acid isomers with conjugated double bonds in dairy products and beef. Studies have advocated that CLA promotes weight loss by enhancing lipolysis and fatty acid oxidation in skeletal muscle. It also reduces lipogenesis and promotes apoptosis in adipose tissue. A placebo-controlled trial evaluated that body fat mass decreased significantly, and derived from konjac root and it CLA as free fatty acid increased lean body mass.

### **Side Effects**

While the toleration level is decent, it can cause adverse effects. Gastrointestinal disturbances include abdominal pain, constipation, diarrhoea, loose stools. nausea, vomiting, and dyspepsia. In addition, it may increase insulin resistance, increased lipoprotein levels, and decreased HDL levels, significantly reduced weight loss leading to metabolic disorders.

### **Capsaicin Supplement**

Capsaicin is present in chilli pepper and has a distinct pungent flavour. It is said to have anti-obesity activities because of its ability to increase energy expenditure, lipid oxidation, reduced postprandial insulin response, and suppressed esophageal obstruction occurs appetite by increased satiety. A intake. However, it did not quantify weight loss.

Research has reported that this substance has increased satiety. However, it induces gastrointestinal distress, causing abdominal pain, burning sensation, nausea, bloating, and acid reflux rather than releasing satiety hormones. It may also increase serum insulin and reduce HDL cholesterol.

### Weight Loss Supplements – Are They

Like every other dietary supplement, weight loss supplements can cause adverse side effects and may interact with prescribed medica-

The amount of scientific information available on weight loss supplement ingredients varies considerably. In most cases, evidence of their proposed benefits consists of limited data from animal and laboratory studies rather than data from human clinical trials.

Furthermore, many combinations of weight loss ingredients are not subject to tests vet, so there's no data on whether the combination supplement is safe or unsafe. In other cases, studies supporting a given ingredient's use are small, of short duration, and poor quality, limiting the strength of the find-

Dosages and amounts of active components vary widely among weight-loss supplements, and a product's composition is not always fully described in published studies. Studies might also use different and sometimes inappropriate assessment techniques to measure the effectiveness of a given treatment.

So, it is better to focus on changing to healthy lifestyle patterns, including a balanced diet, healthy eating habits, clean eating, and regular workout, rather than looking for an easy way to shed the extra weight. Therefore, weight loss supplements are not worth using simply because no appropriate studies describe their weight loss capabilities. Also, one does not know the side effects they may cause to the individual.
