The meeting also reviewed the progress on upgrading 49 dewatering stations, advancing Lalla Ded Hospital project documentation, completing the State **Emergency Operation Center structure** and ongoing electro-mechanical component procurement.

Besides, implementation of Integrated Operational Forecasting System (IOFS), Digital Risk Database (DRDB) and Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) systems was reviewed in detail.

Notably, it was informed that the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) project has connected 72 out of 80 dewatering stations and are ready to be operated remotely by the Srinagar Municipal Corporation.

The Supreme Court in its various judgments has said that the affidavit so submitted should be completely filled in and no column should be left blank.

According to the directions of the Delhi High Court, a candidate who has been in occupation of accommodation provided by the government any time during the last 10 years before the date of notification of the election has to give details of the government dues accrued to him of various departments dealing with government accommodation towards rent, electricity charges, water charges and telephone charges. Ensure preservation of Toshakhana assets

he rich tapestry of history often lies locked away in the treasures of the past, waiting to be unearthed and shared with generations to come. In the case of the Toshakhana assets, the jewels, artifacts, and armory of the erstwhile rulers of Jammu and Kashmir hold not only intrinsic value but also represent a tangible link to the region's cultural heritage. However, the recent saga surrounding the transfer of these assets to the Department of Culture underscores the urgent need for transparency, preservation, and public access. It's heartening to learn that the long-pending process of transferring these invaluable assets to the Department of Culture will likely see fruition in the upcoming months. Yet, the delay and lack of periodic inspections raise concerns about the condition and preservation of these historic articles. It's imperative that steps are taken to ensure their proper upkeep to prevent decay and damage. The decision to close the J&K Toshakhana Organization and transfer its assets to the Department of Culture marks a significant transition. However, this transition must be accompanied by meticulous planning and execution. The insistence on a proper inventory before transfer is understandable, as it ensures accountability and clarity in the handover process. Yet, it's equally crucial that this process doesn't unduly prolong the transfer, risking further neglect of these treasures. One of the key challenges highlighted is the lack of a plan for public display post-transfer. History isn't meant to be locked away; it's meant to be shared and experienced. The Department of Culture, in collaboration with the Directorate of Archives, Archaeology, and Museums, must develop a comprehensive strategy for showcasing these artifacts to the public. This could involve curated exhibitions, educational programs, and digital archives, ensuring accessibility to all, especially the younger generation keen to connect with their heritage. Moreover, the relocation of some items to the strong room in the Civil Secretariat following a fire at the Mubarak Mandi Complex underscores the vulnerability of these assets. Adequate measures must be taken to safeguard them against such risks, including fireproof storage and climate control to mitigate damage from environmental factors. As we look ahead to the completion of the handover process, it's crucial that all stakeholders remain committed to transparency, preservation, and public access. The Department of Culture, the Hospitality and Protocol Department, and other relevant authorities must work in tandem to ensure the seamless transfer and responsible stewardship of these invaluable assets. Let's not merely unlock the doors to history but open them wide for all to behold and cherish. It will also help the people to realize the rich cultural heritage of Dogra rulers in Jammu and Kashmir.
