MAHARAJGANJ (BIHAR), MAY 21

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday anointed all his countrymen as his successor. Reacting sharply to the successor jibe by the Opposition, Modi declared that he has no heir except for the people of his motherland who will be the next-in-line to his legacy.

Addressing a rally here in Bihar in favour of NDA candidates, Modi said: "I do not have any successor and legacy, people of the country are my only successor and legacy".

Modi spoke out on the successor issue with an intention to put an end to spiralling conjectures that Modi will vacate office as he turns 75 (as her his own diktat) and the mantle will fall on Union Home Minister and longtime associate Amit Shah "his successor".

Modi said he would strive for the development of Bihar and Bharat for the bright future of their successor, the people of the country.



Reiterating his commitments for taking strong and major decisions for welfare of the poor, the Prime Minister said that he does not want his successors to face the pangs of poverty any more and appealed to them to again elect a strong government at the Centre for securing a bright future for their next generation.

"Whenever the opposition comes together, they nurture communalism, casteism and dynastic culture to an extreme dimension." Modi alleged adding that the leaders of the opposi-

tion parties were concerned only about their own sons and daughters and not for the common people. He said as June 4, the

KNO CORRESPONDENT SRINAGAR, MAY 21

The Finance Department of Jammu and Kashmir Government on Tuesday announced a 4% increase in Dearness Allowance (DA). This decision, detailed in Government Order No. 8-F of 2024, will be effective from January 1, 2024.

As per the news agency

the order, signed by Principal Secretary Santosh D. Vaidya, stated that the revised DA rate will now be 50% of the basic pay per month. This increment is applicable to all government employees working in regular pay levels as recommended by the 7th Pay Commission.

Key points from the order include the revised DA will be paid in cash from May 2024 onwards, with arrears for the period from January to April 2024. Payment calculations will follow specific rounding rules: fractions of less than 50 paise will be ignored, while those of 50 paise and above will be rounded to the next rupee. The increased DA is classified as part of the monthly salary and does not include any other special pay types.

JK Govt Appoints Nodal Officers for "No Dues **Certificates**" amid ongoing Elections

In a move aimed at streamlining the electoral process, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir has appointed the Divisional Commissioners of Kashmir and Jammu as "Union Territory Level Nodal Officers" responsible for handling requests for "No Dues Certificates" from prospective candidates.

According to Government Order No. 1065-JK(GAD) of

2024, issued by the General Administration Department (GAD) and dated May 20, 2024, this appointment is a critical step in ensuring that candidates meet all necessary prerequisites before participating in the upcoming elections. The order, signed by Commissioner/Secretary to the Government Sanjeev Verma, IAS, covers the responsibilities of the newly appointed nodal officers.

The "No Dues Certificate" is an essential document

that candidates must obtain to confirm they have no outstanding obligations or dues, which is a requisite for eligi bility in the electoral process. The appointment of nodal officers aims to facilitate a smooth and efficient process for candidates to obtain these certificates. The directive has been cire



Patra's faux pas on Lord Jagannath triggers criticism AGENCIES

A faux pas by BJP national spokesperson and Puri Lok Sabha candidate Dr Sambit Patra describing Lord Jagannath as ardent devotee of Narendra Modi, has triggered criticism from various quarters including political circles.

On Monday, after Prime Minister Narendra Modi's road show in Puri, Patra made the grave error in an interview with a TV channel by claiming that Lord Jagannath is a devotee of Narendra Modi.

Though he later apologized and said it was a slip of tongue, by that time his statement was widely circulated on social media, and he was heavily trolled.

Patra said he wanted to say that Prime Minister Narendra Modi is the greatest devotee of Lord Jagannath but said the opposite.

In his X handle, Patra said: "I have made this mistake unintentionally. I know some people must have been hurt but even God forgives mistakes made unintentionally."

He further said, "I need to seek forgiveness from Mahaprabhu Jagannath for this slip of the tongue, and I have decided to do a 'upvaas', for three days."

However, Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik was quick to react to Patra's statement on the TV channel and strongly condemned the BJP leader's statement.

"Taking to his X handle, Patnaik said, "Mahaprabhu Shree Jagannatha is the Lord of the Universe." Calling Mahaprabhu a bhakt of another human being is an insult to the Lord."

This has hurt the (devotees) sentiments and demeaned the faith of crores of Jagannatha bhaktas and Odias across the world," Patnaik said.

Celebrating the power of cultural diversity

Ripples in spice industry amid safety concerns

The recent ban on Indian spices by Singapore, Hong Kong, the Maldives, Australia, and Nepal due to alleged contamination with ethylene oxide (ETO) has sent shockwaves through the industry. This development, involving popular brands like MDH and Everest, could potentially slash spice exports by up to 40%, as per the Federation of Indian Spice Stakeholders. The detection of ETO, a carcinogenic chemical, in spice mixes raises severe health concerns and calls for an urgent overhaul of India's food safety protocols. India's stature as the world's largest producer, consumer, and exporter of spices is now under threat. The country's spice exports exceed \$4 billion annually, with the domestic market valued at \$10 billion. However, recurring quality issues, including the 2014 lead contamination in food coloring and recent bacterial rejections by the US FDA, have marred this reputation. The seizure of over 60,000 kg of adulterated spices in Gujarat last month further exemplifies the crisis. Given the serious health risks posed by ETO, business as usual is not an option for the spice industry. The government's immediate response with stricter quality controls and expanded inspections is a step in the right direction. Yet, these measures must yield tangible improvements to restore global confidence and ensure consumer safety. The presence of carcinogens in spices is a public health issue that demands transparent and decisive action. The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) however have reported that no traces of ETO were found in sampled spices from MDH and Everest facilities. While this is a reassuring preliminary finding, it does not entirely dismiss the contamination concerns raised by foreign authorities. The possibility of contamination during transport, storage, or handling still looms large. Therefore, continuous vigilance and comprehensive quality checks throughout the supply chain are imperative. The government's response must include clear and proactive communication with consumers and international regulators. The public needs assurance that their health is not being compromised. The government's silence on holding culpable companies accountable only fuels consumer anxiety. It is crucial to send a strong message that stringent actions are being taken against any lapses in food safety standards. Transparent operations and a collaborative approach with international food safety bodies are essential to safeguard India's spice legacy. The FSSAI's pan-India inspection drive is a positive move, but it must be followed by consistent enforcement and rigorous testing. The reputation of Indian spices, which significantly contribute to the economy, hinges on maintaining the highest quality standards. The implications of this crisis extend beyond economic losses. It is about preserving trust in a cultural and culinary heritage that dates back centuries. The spice industry is a source of livelihood for millions, from farmers to traders. Protecting this sector means protecting their futures as well. The allegations of ETO contamination in Indian spices are a critical wake-up call. The government, industry stakeholders, and regulatory bodies must work in unison to ensure that Indian spices meet international safety standards. By implementing stringent quality controls, enhancing transparency, and maintaining open communication with global partners, India can reaffirm its position as a leading and reliable exporter of spices. It is a collective responsibility to ensure that the spices, which are a symbol of India's rich heritage, continue to be a source of pride and not of concern.


